



Tournament Rules

- Entry Fee: \$25 (includes \$11.00 lineage and expenses, \$14.00 scholarships awards). On-site entries are \$30 and subject to lane availability. Early registration is strongly recommended.
- Averages: Bowlers will use their highest 2020-21 season (minimum of 21 games) sanctioned average. New bowlers will use their current average (minimum of 9 games) as of February 13, 2022 (submit current standing sheet with entry)
- ✤ Handicap: 90% of 210.
- Eligibility: Bowlers must be current members of a USBC certified youth league in a Greater Lake County certified bowling center.
- Awards: Separate awards will be distributed for the Bantam/Prep, Junior and Major divisions. In addition, there will be three scratch prizes for the highest three *non-cashing* scratch series and three scratch prizes for the **non-cashing** scratch games in each division. In the instance of a tie, prizes will be combined and split equally amongst the bowlers. Cashing ratio will be 1:4 for each division.
- Divisions: Bantam/Prep division is ages 6-11, Junior ages 12-14, and Major division is 15-18 (Age as of August 1, 2021)..
- Dress Code: A collared or league-style shirt is preferred along with dress pants or slacks. Girls may wear skorts or shorts but must reach the tip of their fingertips. ABSOLUTELY NO hats, electronic listening devices, cell phones, smartwatches, clothing or equipment depicting tobacco, alcohol or negative material will be allowed. The tournament committee has the final decision on appropriate attire.
- Format: Bowlers will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes which will be randomly assigned by the tournament committee.
- Coaching: Coaching will be allowed by coaches/parents. The bowler must approach the coach/parent on his/her own. Under no circumstances can a coach/parent enter the bowling area or solicit the bowler to come to them.
- Event rules are subject to change by the host center and/or tournament director based on any Local, State or National COVID mandate changes
