

## **Tournament Rules**

- ❖ Entry Fee: Early bird entry is \$20 (includes \$7.50 lineage and expenses, \$12.50 scholarships awards). On-site entries are \$25 and are based on lane availability. Early registration is strongly recommended.
- ❖ Averages: Bowlers will use their highest 2017-18 season (minimum of 21 games) sanctioned average unless their current average of 12 games or more is higher.
- **\( \text{Handicap: } 90\% \) of 210.**
- Eligibility: Bowlers must be current members of a USBC certified youth league in a Greater Lake County certified bowling center.
- ❖ Awards: Separate awards will be distributed for the Prep and Major divisions. In addition, there will be three scratch prizes for the highest three *non-cashing* scratch scores. In the instance of a tie, prizes will be combined and split equally amongst the bowlers. Cashing ratio will be 1:4 for each division. All SMART Fund winnings must be used by the bowler's 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday.
- Divisions: Prep division is age 13 and under and Major division is 14 and up as of August 1, 2018.
- ❖ Dress Code: A collared or league-style shirt is preferred along with dress pants or slacks. Girls may wear skorts or shorts but must reach the tip of their fingertips. ABSOLUTELY NO hats, electronic listening devices, cell phones, smart watches, clothing or equipment depicting tobacco, alcohol or negative material will be allowed. The tournament committee has the final decision on appropriate attire.
- ❖ Format: Bowlers will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes which will be randomly assigned by the tournament committee.
- ❖ Coaching: Coaching will be allowed by coaches/parents. The bowler must approach the coach/parent on his/her own. Under no circumstances can a coach/parent enter the bowling area or solicit the bowler to come to them.
- ❖ Tournament Goals: Give youth bowlers an opportunity to compete in a fun tournament while earning college scholarships.
